

# CIRCUS SHAWL



**Yarn:** 3 colours of two ply yarn (tvåtrådigt garn) about 100 g of each colour, more if you want to make a really big shawl. Some bobble trim.

**Needles:** A cirkular needle 3,5 (US 4)

This shawl is made in stockinette stitch from the neck down with a scalloped moss stitch trim.

Cast on 7 st.

**Row 1:** Purl 3 st, yarn over, knit one (the center of the shawl), yarn over, purl 3

**Row 2:** Purl

**Row 3:** Purl 3, yarn over, knit one, yarn over, knit one (center), yarn over, knit one, yarn over, purl 3.

**Row 4:** Purl

**Row 5:** Purl 3, yarn over, knit 3, yarn over, knit onw (center), yarn over, knit 3, yarn over, purl 3.

**Row 6:** Purl

**Row 7:** Purl 3, yarn over, knit 5, yarn over, knit one (center), yarn over, knit 5, yarn over, purl 3

**Row 8:** Purl

Change colour after every 8 rows.

Continue in the same way until the shawl has the size you want.

Change to colour 3 an knit 2 rows of moss stitch.

Now you make the scalloped trim. I made them about 20 stitches wide, but make sure to divide equally in the end. It dosen't matter if the edges has slightly different sizes. Knit one part of the moss-stitch trim at a time. After 2 rows of moss stitch start to decrease 1 stitch at the beginning of each row until 4 stitches remain. Cast off.

Make the rest of the trim.

Fasten off all loose ends.

Cut some balls from (bollfrans) and sew one on each edge.

Block or gently iron with a damp cloth.
